

Ilia Kazakov is a member of the ensemble at the Wiener Staatsoper, where he performs roles such as Gremin in *Eugene Onegin*, Don Basilio in *Il Barbiere di Siviglia*, Varlaam in *Boris Godunov*, Doktor Grenvil in *La Traviata*, Bossmän in *Die Entführung ins Zauberreich*, Truffaldino in *Ariadne auf Naxos*, King of Egypt in *Aida*, Zuniga in *Carmen*, Pistola in *Falstaff*, Lord Gualtiero Valton in *I Puritani*, Schließer in *Tosca*, Sergeant in *Manon Lescaut*, Quinault in *Ariadna Lecouvreur*.

In the Summer 2023 Kazakov performed Zuniga in *Carmen* in St. Margarethen Oper im Steinbruch.

His next engagements include debuts with the Berliner Philharmoniker under Kirill Petrenko and at the Salzburg Festival.

Born in 1992, Ilia Kazakov has a degree in choir conducting and vocals. In 2019 Ilia became the Winner and Special Prize Winner of the Galina Vishnevskaya VII International Singing Competition.
